



## Hungary eases Covid19 measures

The number of vaccinated people has reached **6,3 million** in Hungary (meaning **65%** of the population), thus the following measures are in place from **9th March 2022**.

**From 7th March 2022, the government lifted the epidemiological entry restrictions (meaning travellers can enter Hungary without the need for vaccination or immunity certificates or any kind of tests). The government also repealed the decree on the use of masks and vaccination certificates.**

### **GENERAL:**

No restrictions for opening hours for shops, and no restrictions on the number of people entering the shops.

### **HOTELS, RESTAURANTS, BARS, LEISURE FACILITIES (SWIMMING POOLS, SPAS, MUSEUMS, ATTRACTIONS ETC...):**

COVID certificate is not required to access public spaces.

### **RESTRICTIONS FOR BUSINESS EVENTS:**

#### **Outdoors:**

- No restrictions

#### **Indoors:**

- No restrictions

### **MASKS:**

Wearing facemasks is required in health and social care institutions, but is not required in other indoors public spaces, such as stores, shopping centres, post offices, public transport, theatres, cinemas, and at sports events.

### **TRAVELLING TO HUNGARY:**

- Free entrance for all travellers
- Providing general conditions of entry (e.g. valid travel document) is necessary
